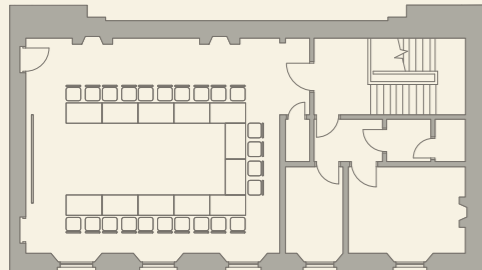
Meeting Rooms

Meeting Hall – The former Meeting Hall is a spacious and tranquil room. The Hall can accommodate approximately 350 people. It has boxed pews facing the raised pulpit area and is suitable for lectures, conferences and festival events. The Meeting Hall has a sound system, wireless access point and internet provision is available.

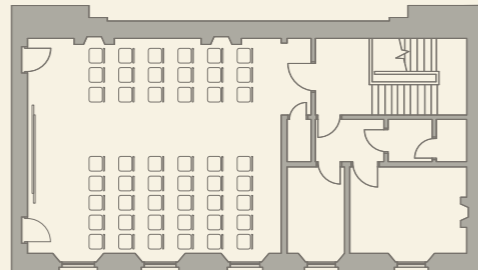
McWilliam Room – The former Feast Room is a large, bright and quiet room with a floor area of approximately 69m². The room is fully flexible and can be set up to suit your needs, theatre or boardroom style or left empty for a variety of other functions including as a break out space for the Meeting Hall. The McWilliam Room can accommodate up to 50 people depending on the function. Some example layouts are shown below.

Office Accommodation – There are several small offices ranging from 6m² to 17m² which would suit between 1 and 4 people and are available to let. Please contact SHBT for details.

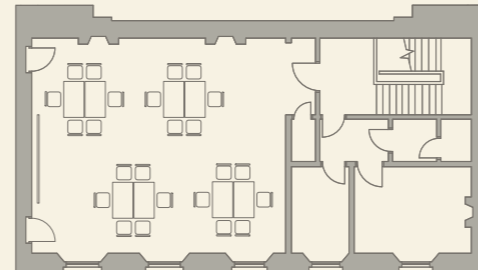

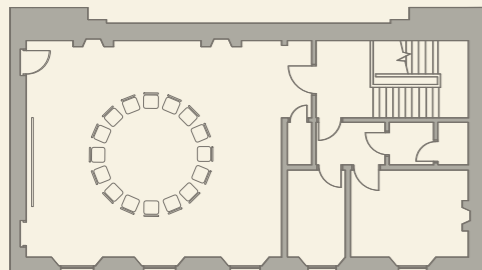
McWilliam Room Layout A



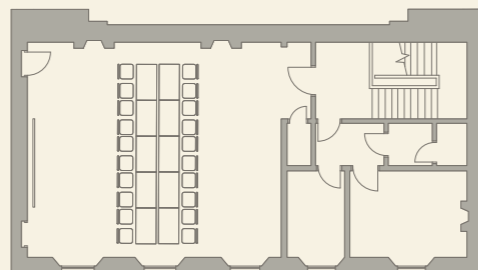
McWilliam Room Layout B



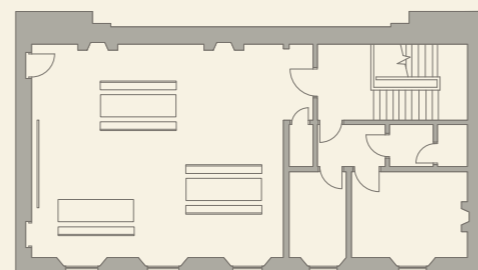
McWilliam Room Layout C

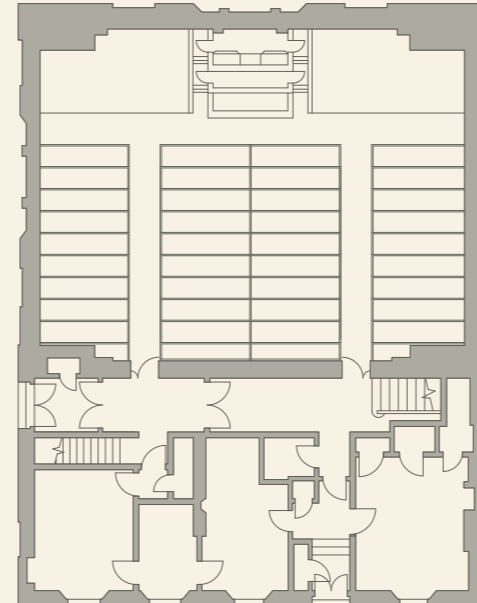


McWilliam Room Layout E

McWilliam Room Floor Plan with Room layouts

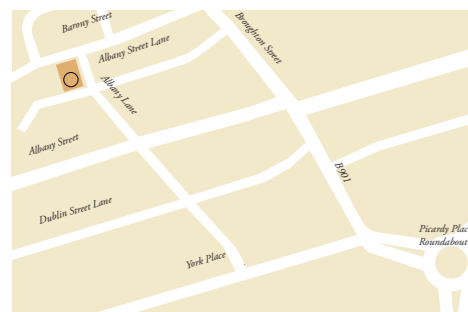


Ground Floor and Meeting Hall



Location

The Glasite Meeting House is located at 33 Barony St. on the periphery of Edinburgh's New Town. It is easily accessible by public transport. Lothian Buses run to Broughton Street whilst St Andrew's Square and Edinburgh's Waverley Station are a 10 minute walk away. Background Information

The Glasite Meeting House is a category A-listed former place of worship of the Edinburgh branch of the Glasites, a small Scottish religious sect. The building was designed by Alexander Black and was completed in 1835. The building's domestic-scaled exterior, plain interior and simple decoration indicate the original Glasite specifications. Graceful architectural details soften the interior spaces. The pulpit in the Meeting Hall was designed by David Bryce in 1873 and two circular windows to the North wall were added for ventilation in 1890 by James B. Dunn. Two original clocks still function in the building today and three of the original feast tables and their benches are still used within the building.

The building has been gifted to Scottish Historic Buildings Trust by the Glasite Meeting House Trust. SHBT manage the building in a manner sympathetic to the history of the building while addressing its current requirement to be viable as a venue and office accomodation.
